PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS 24-HOUR URINE COLLECTION

Your doctor has ordered a test that needs urine collected for 24 hours. This is for diagnosis of your case. Lab test results are based on the sample. The sample must be collected for a full 24 hours. The specimen must be kept refrigerated the entire time.

Please read all these steps before you begin. Call one of the Banner Health numbers below for any questions.

- 1. Write your last and first name, date of birth, height and weight on the bottle.
- Pick a time to start the urine collection. To start, empty bladder as much as possible and <u>THROW AWAY</u> <u>THIS SAMPLE</u>. Document this date and time as the Start Date and Time on the 24-hour urine bottle and in the box below.
- 3. Collect all urine for the next 24 hours. This includes urine before having a bowel movement.
- 4. Keep the sample refrigerated in between collections.
- 5. At the end of the 24-hours, empty bladder and pour this into the bottle.
- 6. Document this date and time as the End Date and Time on the 24-hour urine bottle and in the boxbelow.
- 7. Bring the bottle and all papers for this order and your insurance card to the Lab as soon as possible after finishing.

NOTES:

- The sample cannot be contaminated with stool because this will greatly change the results.
- If for any reason a part of the urine is lost, the results will be wrong. Please start the 24 hours over.
